**‘WINTER WOODLAND RESIDENTIAL’ – HIGH ASHURST**

Following the great successes of our previous ‘Winter Woodland Residential’, we are keen to repeat this trip again. The date of the residential will be Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> January through to Friday 30<sup>th</sup> January 2026; the trip will be for three days and two nights and is available to all children in Year 4.

With this in mind we would like to share with you the information so that you can begin discussing it with your child, thinking about finances and the provided kit list (e.g. keeping old trainers). Please see below a rough itinerary for the trip.

For accommodation the children will be split into 4 large log cabins. Each cabin has 4-5 bedrooms that they will be sharing with their peers. Members of school staff will also sleep in the cabins using separate rooms.

The cost for this trip is **£174.33** which includes accommodation, food, activities as outlined above and transport. This Educational Visit is based on the actual cost of the trip, therefore, unfortunately we are unable to refund £174.33 if, for any reason, your child is unable to attend. Children who are eligible for **Pupil Premium Funding** are offered this visit at the reduced cost of **£87.17**.

If any of our families are experiencing financial difficulty resulting from unforeseen circumstances, do not hesitate to speak to the School Office.

A payment schedule has been set up online for parents should they wish to make payments over the coming weeks. The schedule is set up so that the trip can be paid for as a one-off amount of £174.33 or in three instalments, £80.00 by 31<sup>st</sup> October, £50.00 by 30<sup>th</sup> November and finally £44.33 by 31<sup>st</sup> December. NB Families eligible for Pupil Premium need only pay £87.17 by 30<sup>th</sup> November.

Please note, that should you choose for your child not to be involved in this trip then they must attend school as usual and they will be accommodated in an alternative class.

Please see kit list below to see what your child will require for the trip;

- Hand torch (**no head torches**)
- At least two pairs of shoes e.g. two pairs of trainers (they will get muddy and probably wet so preferably old pairs)
- Waterproof jacket (waterproof/windproof trousers are highly recommended)
- Warm coat
- Hat, scarf and gloves
- Change of clothes / spare underwear
- Towel and wash kit
- Pyjamas and slippers or thick socks for walking around the cabin
- Layers and spare clothes.
- A cuddly toy!
