Subject of the Week – History

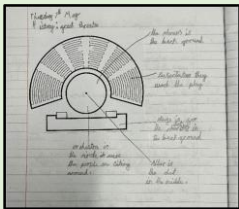
Year 1 have been learning the stories of 6 famous rulers. This week they have learnt about Queen Elizabeth I and King Henry VIII.



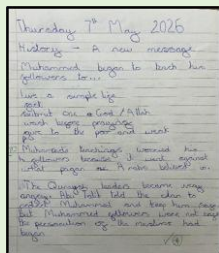
Year 2 have been looking at the Stone Age and have created some wonderful art inspired by Stonehenge.

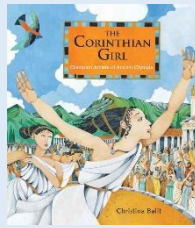
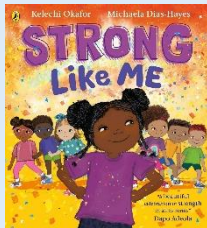
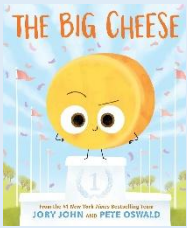
Ewell Grove Games 2026
