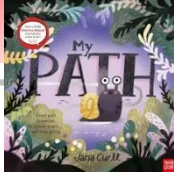

Subject of the Week – PSHE



Last week, some Year 3 children took part in Feet First – Walking Training for schools, commissioned by Surrey County Council.

The training course provides children with road safety skills to better enable them to safely walk to and from school with their parents and carers and prepare them for independent travel. It is taught through a combination of classroom and practical roadside sessions.

Quote “Feet First was so much fun. We got to learn how to be safe and cross the roads. I liked the pelican crossings because the name is funny. Also, in the online bits that we had to watch there was a monkey called Dexter and he was funny”.



Year 5 were lucky enough to be visited by St John Ambulance, who delivered a workshop, to each class, sharing with them what to do in a medical emergency. They learnt:

- How to approach an unresponsive patient
- How to check if they were breathing
- How to put someone in the recovery position

They were also fortunate enough to be able to learn and practise, using medical aides, how to perform CPR and why CPR is important. The children found it tricky to keep to the correct, recommended pace when performing CPR until they were told to do it in time with the song “Staying Alive”.

The Year 5 teachers were incredibly proud of how sensible and mature the children were. Thank you to St John Ambulance for visiting.

On Tuesday, Ewell Grove took 16 children from the Country Dancing Club to take part in the Country Dance Festival at the Kingsmeadow Stadium. 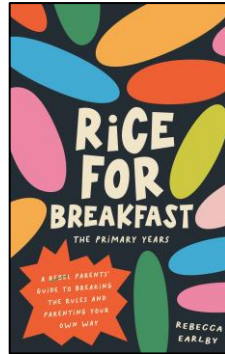
