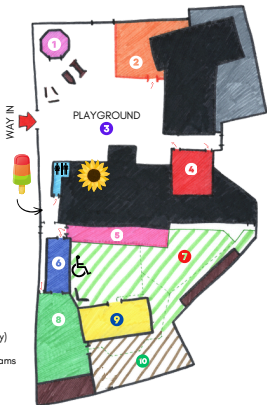

NOTICES, HEALTH & SAFETY

1

First aid is available at the **Entry Table** by the Entrance (main playground), or you can ask **school staff members** for assistance. Ice packs will also be available in the Hall for any bouncy castle bumps!

2

Please **supervise young children** at all times. The school will be busy and is open to the public.

3

Lost children: please go to the Entry or Change stalls on the playground, or speak to a member of FOEG Committee (identifiable in hi-vis vests) who can arrange for an announcement to be made.

4

If you require access to a **disabled toilet**, or **step-free access** to the Orchard, please speak to a member of FOEG Committee/School staff.

5

Most stalls are **CASH ONLY** – please come prepared! (See page 7) *Refreshments/BBQ orders, merchandise & ice cream, bouncy castle, and Pure Pamper can accept card payments.*





SEN FAMILIES



At this year's Summer Fair, the Friends of Ewell Grove have introduced some adjustments to support our **SEN families**, which we hope will make the experience more **enjoyable and inclusive**.

These include:



1

'Quiet Hour' 11.30am-12.30pm (SEN families only)

The majority of the stalls will be available, including the bouncy castle, slime stall, face painting, badge making, the BBQ & refreshments and some games stalls too.

2

Sensory Bags will be available to use at the Fair, including items such as fidget toys, sand timers, sunglasses and ear defenders to help with sensory overload. Bags can be collected from/returned to the **Fair entry table**.

3

A **SEN Quiet Area** will be available in the office foyer, which will be converted to a calm, quiet space for SEN families to breakout and have a breather from the busy Fair festivities. You will need a **sunflower lanyard** to access this space (available from the Fair entry table).





CASH AND CHANGE



The best way you can help us manage the money at the fair is to **come prepared with lots of loose change**, particularly **50p, £1 or £2 coins!**

For when this is not possible, we ask that you please use our **Change Stall**, which will ease the burden of handling and giving change on all the other stalls. After you have bought your entry ticket, you are invited to **change any UK bank notes into pound coins** before going around the rest of the fair.

Located on the playground **near the entrance** of the fair, the stall will be manned **from 11:30 until 14:30** (by the final hour of the fair, we envisage that stall floats should have enough coins to change any last remaining bank notes).

Most stalls will not be able to give change from £10 or £20 notes during the first two hours of the fair in order to avoid depleting their floats too quickly (a notable **exception** is the Refreshments stall, which will be able to give change for larger purchases). This also reduces the workload for our volunteers running around stalls to swap notes for coins!

BOUNCY CASTLE



£1.50 per turn or buy an
***Unlimited Wristband for £4**
and go back on as many times as you like!

**Unlimited, but not continuous -
it will be necessary to queue for each additional turn.*

Please note:

1. **Health and safety rules** (set out and displayed by the bouncy castle company) must be adhered to at all times.
2. **NO FACE PAINT** is allowed on the bouncy castle. Please make sure you bounce first, and face paint later!
3. A turn lasts 3 minutes, with a maximum of 10 children allowed on at a time.
4. Children will be asked to queue on the rows of benches - they may be grouped according to age or height in order to keep the fun safe for all ages, so will not necessarily bounce in exact order of arrival.
5. You can prepare for and maximise your turn by removing shoes as soon as you reach the front bench that means you are next in the queue. Shoes will be gathered into a box and moved to the exit door ready for the end of your turn.
6. Access to the Hall is from the playground only (not from the Orchard) and there is a **one way system** in place to ensure safe queuing. There will be **no through route** between the playground and the Orchard via the Hall. Please do not go, or allow children to go, past the barriers or behind the bouncy castle.
7. Prams and pushchairs cannot be taken into the hall - please park them outside.
