End of Term

Reception to Year 5 – last day of term is **Friday 17th July** with an early finish time of **12 midday**.

Year 6 – Final Assembly

Friday 17th July is the last day of term for children in Year 6. The Year 6 final assembly starts at **12:45pm** (2 seats available per family – no children on laps).

Please note the only children staying for lunch on the last day of term are Year 6. School catering lunches will not be available on this day.

Subject of the Week – Music

Across the school, the children have been drawing on the skills they have learnt throughout the year such as improvisation and composition using their knowledge of musical notation.

Year one has looked particularly at note length using crotchets and minims.

They started by clapping back rhythms, then worked on recording informally using a dash and dot representation.

Finally, they progressed to the formal recording of written crotchets and minims.



Free School Meals (FSM)

The Department for Education has introduced a major expansion of the FSM program, bringing essential updates to how entitlements are calculated and verified. From **1st September 2026**, all children from households receiving Universal Credit will now qualify for free school meals.

Crisis and Resilience Fund – Support for families during the Summer holidays

The UK Government funded Crisis and Resilience Fund is available to those on low incomes who face sudden financial pressures. It is currently in the process of being set up by Surrey County Council and partners across Surrey to determine how best to allocate this limited funding, which is lower than previous Household Support Fund funding, so that both short-term and longer-term initiatives reach those who need support the most.

Ordinarily Available Provision (OAP)

We're pleased to share that the Ordinarily Available Provision (OAP) bitesize videos are now available on the Local Offer website.

OAP is delivered from resources ordinarily available to each school alongside high-quality teaching. These short videos have been co-produced in collaboration with school-based SENCOs, Inclusion Leads, and Heads of SEND Units across all phases, and Surrey colleagues. The videos demonstrate how OAP can be used, adapted, and further developed in practice across a range of school contexts.

The aim of this resource is to offer insight into practice across different types of schools and perspectives, to strengthen alignment with guidance, and promote a consistent, collaborative approach to meeting needs.

[Video 1](#) - explores what OAP means to professionals working in schools, and how it positively impacts the school community by promoting fairness and consistency.

[Video 2](#) - focuses on implementation, exploring the nuances of applying OAP practice across different school contexts, with practical examples of reasonable adjustments, resources developed by schools to support OAP delivery, and the benefits of a whole school commitment to OAP.

[Video 3](#) - looks at Relational Practice: what it means in the classroom, addressing some common misconceptions, and outlines the wider impact across the school community.

Could you be an Independent Visitor for a child in care?

Surrey Independent Visitor Service is seeking volunteers (21+) to spend a few hours each month supporting a child or young person in foster care.

Independent Visitors build a consistent, trusting 1:1 relationship—offering time, encouragement, and opportunities to enjoy simple activities together. Many young people benefit from having a trusted adult who is independent of the wider support network around them.

We are particularly keen to hear from people with experience of working with children and young people, especially those with additional needs, disabilities, or who have experienced adversity or complex life circumstances. Volunteers should be reliable, patient, and empathetic.

Training, ongoing support, and expenses are provided. Volunteers are asked to commit to monthly visits for a minimum of two years.
